The Tudor Trust is an independent grant-making trust which supports charities and community groups working across the UK. We do not focus our funding on specific themes or programmes but instead want to support a wide range of people and organisations working to achieve lasting change in their communities. Tudor aims to support work which addresses the social, emotional and financial needs of people at the margins of society, and is interested in how organisations tackle these needs, and their root causes.

Tudor is most interested in helping smaller, under-resourced organisations which offer direct services and which involve the people they work with in their planning. We do not have fixed funding priorities but are looking for a number of key characteristics in the organisations we fund. These include:

- Organisations which are embedded in and have developed out of their community – whether the local area or a ‘community of interest’
- Organisations providing direct services to marginalised people
- A focus on building stronger communities by overcoming isolation and fragmentation and encouraging inclusion, connection and integration
- High levels of user involvement, and an emphasis on self-help where this is appropriate
- Work which addresses complex and multi-stranded, often difficult, problems in unusual or imaginative ways
- Organisations and people who know what difference they want to make and have the energy and vision to make it happen

We are most likely to fund groups with an annual turnover of less than £1 million.

The 392 grants and two loans committed over the year addressed our ultimate aim of tackling the social, emotional and financial needs of people on the margins of society in many different ways. Reflecting our continued move away from fixed funding priorities the work we supported was hugely varied in terms of location, issues tackled, scale and approach - from a horticulture project for ex-offenders in Devon to a community hall refurbishment in Peterhead; from the integration of migrant workers in Norfolk to counselling for the families of alcohol misusers in South Wales.

We continue to be inspired by the passion and energy with which the groups we support tackle the challenges they face, by their creativity and diversity, and by their determination to make a real difference in the communities in which they work.
