The Tudor Trust is an independent grant-making trust which supports charities and community groups working across the UK. We do not focus our funding on specific themes or programmes but instead want to support a wide range of people and organisations working to achieve lasting change in their communities. Tudor aims to support work which addresses the social, emotional and financial needs of people at the margins of society, and is interested in how organisations tackle these needs, and their root causes.

On 1 April 2006 Tudor introduced new funding guidelines which outlined our approach to supporting organisations. Tudor is most interested in helping smaller, under-resourced organisations which offer direct services and which involve the people they work with in their planning. We do not have fixed funding priorities but are looking for a number of key characteristics in the organisations we fund. These include:

- Organisations which are embedded in and have developed out of their community – whether the local area or a ‘community of interest’
- Organisations providing direct services to marginalised people
- A focus on building stronger communities by overcoming isolation and fragmentation and encouraging inclusion, connection and integration
- High levels of user involvement, and an emphasis on self-help where this is appropriate
- Work which addresses complex and multi-stranded, often difficult, problems in unusual or imaginative ways
- Organisations and people who know what difference they want to make and have the energy and vision to make it happen

We are most likely to fund groups with an annual turnover of less than £1 million.

This grants list details the grants made by the Tudor Trust from April 2006 to March 2007. Most of these grants were made to applicants applying under these new guidelines, although some were made to groups who applied under previous guidelines which ran to the end of March 2006.

The 397 grants made over the year reflect the Trust's main aim of tackling the social, emotional and financial needs of people on the margins of society. As we don't make grants in line with identified funding priorities the sort of work we support is hugely varied – from a community centre in the Outer Hebrides to crisis support for people with mental health problems in Leeds; from street-based youth work in Derry to work with exploited migrant domestic workers in London.

The common thread linking all the organisations we funded over the year is not necessarily what they do or who they work with, but their clear sense of the difference they want to make, their energy and vision and their willingness to grapple with complex and difficult issues.
